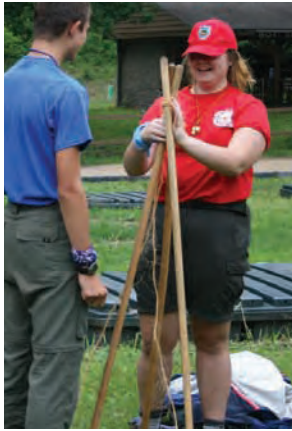

Qualifications to Attend

- Registered with the Boy Scouts of America
- Be at least age 14, or 13 and have Completed the Eighth Grade
- Completed the Rank of First Class*
- Completed Introduction to Leadership Skills for Troops/Crews
- Unit Leader Recommendation
- Complete Medical Form (A,B,C) with No Restrictions



*For 2019 only, an exception will be granted for girls registered in Scouts BSA to attend NYLT without first achieving the First Class rank.
