

ANNUAL TOUR PERMIT APPLICATION

For Trips and Camps 100 Miles or Less

This application must be filed with the Blackhawk Area Council service center and is used for trips of 100 miles or less from your regular meeting place. The Annual Tour Permit covers a period of one year from the date of submission. If destination exceeds 100 miles but less than 500 miles, a separate Local Tour Permit (#34426C) must be applied for.

A Local Tour Permit must be applied for if any of the following exists:

- > **Swimming** > **Climbing** > **High Ropes** > **Other potential hazardous activity**
- > **Boating** > **Rappelling** > **Leave Council boundary**
