## ATTENTION CUB SCOUT LEADERS SAFETY RECALL OF CUB SCOUT ITEM

Oct. 5, 2007

Fellow Cub Scout Leaders,

It appears that we have lead in the Cub Scout Immediate Recognition Kit emblem. (see the photo)

Please advise your parents, Den and Pack Leaders to collect them so they can be returned to the council.

In the interest of safety and peace of mind for parents:

- We will accept back all of the emblems regardless of when they were purchased. (The beads are ok... it's just the emblem part).
- Ask someone in each Pack to collect the emblems and send them to the Trading Post with their contact information. When we get the replacement shipment in, we'll swap them out, either at the Trading Post, or at your Roundtables. It's too early to tell how long it will take to receive replacements.
- We encourage you to collect the emblems in you pack and send us a group return.
- We only want the White plastic emblems that read "Progress Toward Ranks". Do not send the string or beads.

We want to make this as easy as possible for our people.

Also, for your information, we, the BSA, initiated the tests on the stuff the domestic supplier company sent us, which they had out-sourced, so I'm proud we are aggressively looking for lead, especially in light of all of the toy recalls.

Please note that the Tiger recognitions are not tainted. The Tiger emblems ARE safe.
