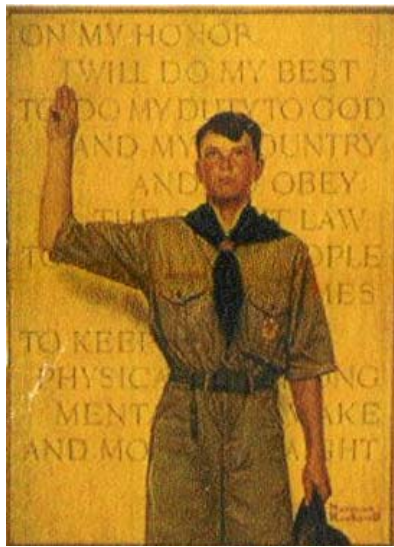

Our Mission

The National Youth Leadership Training course has six objectives:

- To give participants the confidence and knowledge to run the troop program
- To give participants a working knowledge of the eleven skills of leadership and help them relate these skills to their troop responsibilities.
- To give participants the opportunity to share ideas and experiences with Scouts from other troops.
- To create an environment of Scouting fellowship and fun guided by the Scout Oath and Law – Scouting at its best.
- To develop a relationship between the participant and his Scoutmaster.
- To have fun.

Who can go

The Scout must be at least 13 years of age and completed the seventh grade by the date of the course, hold the rank of First Class or above, and be in a leadership position or likely to be in one in the near future. Scoutmasters should not allow exceptions to age and rank requirements. Be aware, experience has shown that Scouts younger than 13 often lack the physical and emotional maturity to benefit fully from the NLYT experience. Those who have not earned the First Class rank do not have the Scouting background to fulfill their roles as members of their NYLT patrol and troop.

Cost

The course fee is \$150.00. This will include one participant t-shirt, meals, and course material, along with a patrol photo taken by a professional photographer. If you register your Scout(s) after May 1st 2010 the fee is \$170.00. Payment in full is needed prior to May 1st in order not to be charged the late fee.
