



WLOT & BALOO



This year you can complete both your BALOO (Basic Adult Leader Outdoor Orientation) and WLOT (Webelos Leader Outdoor Training) at the same time.

At BALOO training you will learn how to plan and carry out outdoor experiences for your pack. The goal of a pack camping activity is to provide: FUN, ACTIVITIES, and ADVANCEMENT. This training is required for a pack to go camping.

Then stay and complete the WLOT training and learn the ins and outs of Webelos Outdoor Program. This is a hands-on course, you'll be Cooking, Tying Knots, learn about the Webelos Outdoor Activity Badges, Webelos to Scout Transition, First Aid, Camping equipment and more. You'll even learn how to cook in a cardboard box oven. This course is required for the Webelos Den Leaders Award (Knot).

A registration fee of \$15.00 for BALOO only & \$20.00 for BALOO & WLOT is due Friday, October 1st, 2010. This fee includes lunch, dinner, patches and all materials. NOTE: in order to have adequate material available, we will be unable to accept late registrations.
