



## Wood Badge Personal Equipment List

### Required

- 🔪 Official Scout uniform(s) for your current Scouting position (Note: A complete uniform includes the official shirt; shorts, long pants, skirts, or culottes; socks; and belt. (A neckerchief, slide, and cap will be provided.)
- 🔪 Scout activity uniform(s) (Note: An activity uniform includes a Course / Troop 1 Scout T-shirt and Scout shorts, long pants, skirts, or culottes.)
- 🔪 The course will provide a scout cap
  
- 🔪 Shoes or boots
- 🔪 Windbreaker or jacket\*
- 🔪 Rain gear (poncho or rain suit)\*
- 🔪 Sleep wear
- 🔪 Under garments
- 🔪 Handkerchiefs
- 🔪 Sunscreen\*
- 🔪 Insect repellent\*
- 🔪 Sleeping bag, ground pad, and air mattress or cot (Second weekend)
- 🔪 Flashlight with spare batteries and bulb\*
  
- 🔪 Pocketknife or multiple tool-type knife (No fixed-blade knives)\*
- 🔪 Medication in labeled containers\*
- 🔪 Toiletries and personal hygiene items
- 🔪 Towels and washcloths
- 🔪 Pen, pencils, pocket notebook\*
- 🔪 Canteen or water bottle and travel cup\*
- 🔪 Handbook for your Scouting program
- 🔪 Day pack suitable bag for carrying your daily gear \*

\* These items should be in your day pack. Due to tight schedule we will not return to the cabins for personal gear all day.

A List of additional items for the Outdoor Experience (Second Weekend) will be provided at the course.

### Optional

- 🔪 Pillow
- 🔪 Change of shoes
- 🔪 Moccasins or camp slippers
- 🔪 Shower footwear
- 🔪 Sunglasses
  
- 🔪 Religious book(s)
- 🔪 Books of camp songs, skits, etc.
- 🔪 Camera and film
- 🔪 Sheet to lay down over bed bunk

🔪 Note: The following electronic devices may not be used during a course: cellular telephones, pagers, radios, televisions, CD players, tape players, and any other devices that could interrupt Wood Badge presentations or activities.

🔪 During the first weekend you will be staying in one of the camps cabins or you may pitch a tent. (There is little time to pitch a tent until after the first day presentations.) The cabins are equipped with bunk bed with a mattress pad. It's not the Hilton . . .
